The Warren Consolidated Schools Board of Education is conducting a comprehensive search for its next Superintendent. The new Superintendent is expected to start July 1, 2024.

Warren Consolidated Schools is a public school district located within the Metropolitan Detroit area of southeast Michigan. The district serves a diverse population of students from the cities of Sterling Heights, Warren, and a portion of Troy. Warren Consolidated Schools is committed to academic excellence through student achievement, high expectations, and strong relationships.

Warren Consolidated Schools is home to three high schools, four middle schools and 12 elementary schools that serve nearly 13,000 students. The district is home to an alternative education center, a Mathematics Science Technology center, and a Career and Technical Education center. Warren Consolidated employs more than 1,800 staff members, including 876 teachers, 60 administrative staff members, and nearly 900 support staff members. Warren Consolidated Schools has an annual operating budget of \$211,239,000, with a foundation allowance of \$10,455 per pupil, and a fund balance projected to be over \$18,000,000 as of June 30, 2024.

Students in Warren Consolidated Schools are afforded a world of opportunities that include preschool, World of Fours, and Early Childhood Special Education, transitional kindergarten, state-of-the-art instructional technology in all classrooms, championship athletics, award-winning band programs, innovative Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) programs, high school advanced placement programs, dual enrollment programs, and the Early College of Macomb program.

Warren Consolidated Schools offers several specialty programs for students, which include:

- Nationally recognized Performing Arts High School
- High School Macomb Mathematics Science Technology Center
- Career Preparation Center with 15 state approved Career and Technical Education programs
- Middle School Mathematics Science Technology Center
- Middle School Visual and Performing Arts

The mission of Warren Consolidated Schools, in partnership with families and community, is to achieve a level of excellence in teaching and learning which enables all students to become knowledgeable, productive, ethical, and successful citizens.
