Design opportunities for communicating reasoning-- Use PLC/team meetings to determine resources and common language that will facilitate implementation of writing across the curriculum. Teachers will meet to determine an appropriate common rubric for CER writing. 2. Use PLC time to map out opportunities to write that build across grade level and map out opportunities to write that build from one subject to another 3. Team Rubric Scoring--staff will meet during PLC/team meetings to score papers for grade level standards, reliability, and consistency across teacher, grade, and subject area. Anchor Text Sets--Teachers will collect examples of work across rubric scores for use in future scoring activities for the purpose of increasing reliability and fidelity of scoring writing that communicates reasoning.
