Dear Summer School Parents/Guardians and Staff:

A staff member in our summer school program tested positive for COVID-19, prompting the district to implement our WCS COVID Policy and Procedures, which include:

- The Macomb County Health Department was notified and provided the district guidance on our response based on the available information.
- Students and staff were moved away from the area where the affected individual had been located.
- 3. The affected areas were cleaned and disinfected to minimize the potential exposure. This includes offices, bathrooms, classrooms, and other areas.

As a precautionary measure, it is recommended that all students and staff self-monitor on a daily basis, and stay home if symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, diarrhea, body aches, or loss of taste or smell occur.
