Our district's operating millage is up for renewal on Tuesday, May 2, 2017. I am proud to announce that we are seeking a **10-YEAR ZERO-TAX-RATE-INCREASE OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL**, and I want to insure that all community members understand what is our operating millage.

Every 10 years we turn to our community to vote on the school operating millage, 60% of which is funded by businesses in our area with the other 40% from homeowners. This millage comprises almost 25% of our operating budget and is primarily used for in-classroom learning such as teachers, support staff, and school principals; books and materials; and programs such as athletics, the fine and performing arts, and many other outstanding extracurricular activities.

We are proud of our school board's diligence in maintaining a balanced budget and cutting unneeded expenses, making this **ZERO-TAX-RATE INCREASE OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL** possible. I have enclosed a copy of the ballot language along with information regarding this millage.
